

iPad Setup

Setting Safari Website Restrictions

For efficient visibility reasons, the images to the right are in *portrait (vertical)* rather than *landscape (horizontal)*. The VFP DGR, Tour, and DE should be locked at the *landscape* setting.

1. Settings
2. General
3. Tap **Restrictions**





Restrictions

1. Tap **Enable Restrictions**

You can choose to restrict any of your apps on this device, however, for this purpose we are focusing on **Safari**.



Setting Safari Website Restrictions

Allowed Content

1. Tap **Websites**
2. Tap **Specific Websites Only**
This action *may* populate a bunch of child-rated apps by default, simply delete each of these from the list by swiping to the left on each one.
3. Tap **Add a Website...**

Setting Safari Website Restrictions - **Allowed Websites**

ALLOW VFP+ Digital Suite:


1. In the Title box, type “**Guest Register**”
2. **ALLOW VFPnext:** In the URL box, type “<http://www.vfpnext.com>”
3. Tap **Websites** to return to list

ALLOW the VFP+ Tour:

1. Tap **Add a Website...**
2. In the Title box, type “**Tour**”
3. **ALLOW the Tour:** In the URL box, type “<http://www.mivfp.com>”
4. Tap **Websites** to return to list

Do the same for:

- NAME: “VFP Avatar”
URL: <http://fitnessplanner-j6151b6a.cloudapp.net/>
NAME: “VFP Server”
URL: <http://www.myvfp.com>

Setting Safari Website Restrictions

Allowed Websites - Guest Register Only

1. Notice “**Guest Register**” and “**Tour**” are now in the **ONLY ALLOW THESE WEBSITES:** list

At this point, you may wish to add other websites that you would allow if applicable. Other websites you may want to add would be:







1. Tap **Guided Access**



Guided Access Setup

1. Tap to toggle **Guided Access ON** to enable it and configure it



Isolating **Safari** as the Only Usable App (with the website restrictions in place) Using Guided Access

Guided Access Setup

1. Tap **Passcode Settings**
2. Tap **Set Guided Access Passcode**
This passcode is used to enable or disable the device's Guided Access. It will be required to take the iPad out of Guided Access or to configure Guided Access going forward.




iPad Setup

Removing suggested sites from Safari browser for a clean, isolated Guest Register experience. This will keep anything from popping up if the user taps the address bar, keeping them securely in the Guest Register

Simple Safari Setup

1. Settings
2. Tap **Safari**
3. Turn **off Search Engine Suggestions**
4. Turn **off Safari Suggestions**
5. Turn **off Preload Top Hit**
6. Turn **off Frequently Visited Sites**

Make sure your Safari settings look like the picture on the right.





AutoFill settings.

Simple Safari Setup

1. Settings
2. Tap **Safari**
3. Tap AutoFill
4. Turn **off Use Contact Info**
5. Turn **off Names and Passwords**
6. Turn **off Credit Cards**


Make sure your Safari settings look like the picture on the right.



iPad Setup

The iPad now has website restrictions in place, restricting Safari to the Guest Register only, this should be the site you see when you open Safari.


To enable Guided Access and remove access to any app but Safari, see the next slide.



Enabling a Guided Access Session for Safari

1. Open **Safari**
2. **Triple-press the home button** on the front of the iPad
You will see a black frame appear around a zoomed-out Safari window.
3. Tap **Begin or Resume** in the upper right corner to start a Guided Access session for Safari
Resume will appear if you've had a Guided Access session for Safari before. You can also set other restrictions from here for the Guided Access session.



Disabling a Guided Access Session for Safari

1. **Triple-press the home button**
2. Tap **End** in the upper left corner



iPad Setup - Network Testing

Required (prior to Go-Live Date) Network and Apple iPad/Tablet Testing

1. **Connect your iPhone or Apple iPad to the WiFi** network that is being used to run the Digital Suite on their Apple iPads.
2. **Open a browser** on the device you're testing.
3. Navigate to speed.vfpnext.com
4. **Tap "GO"** and let the speed test run.
5. Once the test is complete, **tap the "Copy Link"** button.
6. **Send the link to us** via the Support Chat anywhere in vfpnext.com, or:
Please mention the **area the test was run when delivering the link via support chat.
7. **Send the link to crunch@vfp.us.**
Edit the Subject line of the email to include your **brand, location and **area the test was run**. (e.g. front desk, reception area, women's locker room, group-x room, front desk, free-weight room, etc.)

Run several tests around all areas and along the route the team will take when using the VFP+ Digital Suite.
